


# MLA 8 in Brief

### **Formatting your Document**

- \* It is important to check with your instructor. Many programs use different formatting. Follow the instructions given to you in class.
  - Use 1-inch margins, 12-point font, and double spacing.
  - Page number is in top right, with your last name before it.
  - Indent the first line of paragraphs one half-inch.
  - Right before the title, include the following, flush to the left:
    - o Your name
    - o Your instructor's name
    - The course
    - The date: day, month, year
  - Center the title, in the same font as the rest of the document.
  - Use one space between sentences.

# **Giving Credit**

If you use someone's words or ideas, you need to give credit to the source. This is a two-step process:



1. Create a reference, kept in a list of references near the end of your document. This list of references is called Works Cited or may be called Bibliography.



2. A short version (citation) in the text where you used the ideas or words. This citation directs your audience to the full information in the Works Cited list.



Containers: Sometimes a source is found within a larger item (a container). Examples of containers: a journal, a TV series, a website, a database, and a book (if the source is a chapter in it). Repeat elements 3-9 as needed for the containers you have.




#### **Works Cited List**

The list of references is in alphabetical order, by the first word of the reference. Omit any articles (a, an, the) when alphabetizing references starting with the title. Indent the second and following lines.

## **Citations (In the Text)**

When you use people's ideas or words, you will add a short note leading to the full information in the list of references. You will also add the specific location of the ideas, words, or quotation, if this information is available (e.g. page number, or chapter number).




You may have a longer quotation, defined as more than four lines. Usually you introduce the quotation, but offset the actual quotation one half-inch from the left margin:

Lorem ipsum dolor sit amet, at mel erat congue minimum. Mel eligendi cotidieque at, probatus vituperata disputationi ad duo. Et eam salutatus posidonium dissentias, eu purto ludus essent pri. Voluptua adolescens ut ius, tota natum praesent ex pro, ad vix tempor aliquando. Ad aeque facete putant has, viris mentitum sententiae ei quo, mel ut audire hendrerit definiebas. (Someone)

Note the citation is in parentheses, but it appears after the last sentence.

For paraphrasing and summarizing, use a similar method to the short quotation. The methods above may be altered, as the main idea is to give credit in an unambiguous way while minimizing interrupting the flow of the text (*MLA* 54).
